Congratulations Violet Abdulla - the CDP candidate for Watson, and Josh Green - the CDP candidate for Chifley on achieving our highest results in a Federal Election lower house seat.

Violet received 7,957 primary votes (which was 9.56% of the total vote in Watson), with an incredible 7.19% swing towards the CDP. Similarly in Chifley, Josh received 7,820 primary votes (9.14% of the total vote in Chifley) with a swing of 5.68%. Well done!

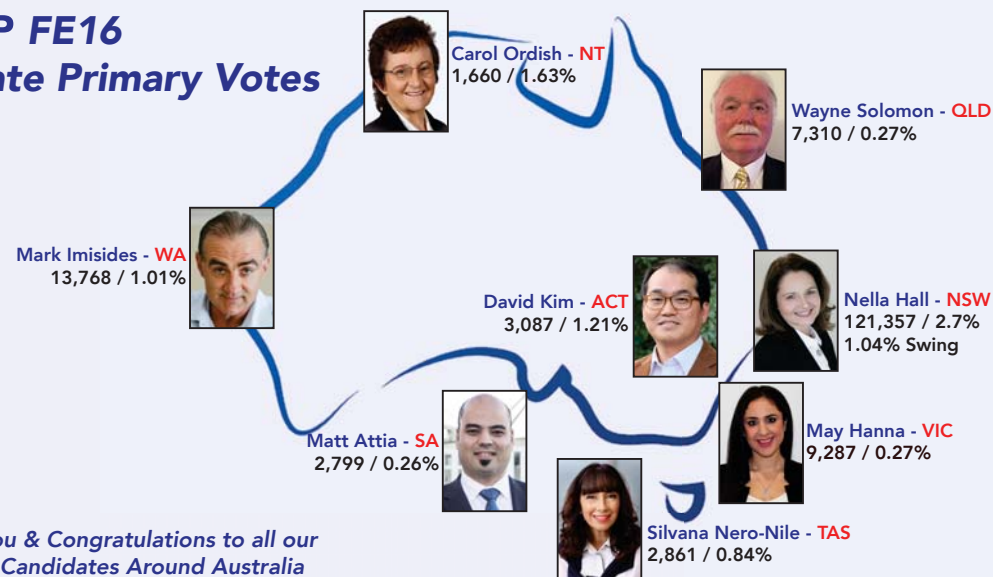
