Alan Jones has been a permanent fixture in the Australian radio landscape for decades. His announcement this week that he will be retiring from the profession will leave a lasting mark on the national press. Jones was a reporter of and for the people, and so his future absence from the airwaves surely constitutes a great loss for the journalistic profession; he and his work will be sorely missed by his listeners.

Alan Jones was a great believer on the Australian federal system of government as it was intended to be by the framers of our national Constitution. He was one of the very few voices in the mainstream press who understood the value of our history heritage and had the courage to stand up against the cultural vandals who have spared no effort to undermine our sovereignty and national confidence.

He will be remembered for many things, but perhaps the most memorable will be his fearless interrogation of the theory of human induced global warming and the radical green agenda that underpins it. 
by technocrats, managers and other so-called “experts” who purport to know what is best for the people in spite of the popular will.
