PETITION TO FEDERAL PARLIAMENT

Safety, Ethical, Mandatory concerns of Australians

Regarding SARS-Cov-2 vaccines

For immediate circulation

Those concerned about the ongoing threat to religious and civil liberties that any mandatory vaccine for Covid 19 might pose to people of faith are encouraged to have their say at the online petition which will be tabled in the Federal Parliament. The reasons and particulars of the petition are as follows:

Petition Reason

Many Australians support finding a safe and effective vaccine for COVID-19 to control its spread in our country. However, regarding COVID-19 vaccines to be made available in Australia, many are concerned that the government may implement coercive measures on Australians to vaccinate; whether they have been developed using aborted foetal cells and/or have concerns about the safety of fast-tracked vaccines.

Petition Request

We therefore ask the House to:

- 1. Reject mandatory or coercive measures for Australians to vaccinate against COVID-19.*
- 2. Provide Australians the option of a COVID-19 vaccine that has not been developed using aborted foetal cells.*
- 3. Fully address safety concerns of a COVID-19 vaccine for Australians and ensure the details about the development processes and tests that have, or have not, been conducted on the vaccine's safety, be made publicly available.*
